Dear Educator,

Leadership York will proudly celebrate the 18<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Leadership for Diverse Schools (LDS) program in May. Eighteen years helping over 500 educators build culturally proficient communities in their districts and agencies so that all students can feel like they belong. During these 18 years we have explored best practices focusing on race, religion, gender, sexual orientation, socio-economic status, and trauma with the goal of helping all students feel accepted and respected.

We are looking to our 19<sup>th</sup> year (2024-2025) and making plans for an even better, more inclusive experience responding to the needs of educators during these challenging times. Attached you will find an application for the 2024-2025 LDS class and proposed calendar of sessions. We hope that you will share them with any colleague who may be interested.

The tuition fee is \$1,500, and Act 48 credit hours are available for teachers. For just \$33/class hour, educators can examine their biases, challenge the "status quo," and learn effective practices to create positive, safe learning environments. A similar experience at a local graduate school would cost more than \$3000.

I am hoping we can include employees from your agency/district as part of the 2024-2025 LDS Class.

## What is Leadership for Diverse Schools?

LDS is a Leadership York program for those who work with and for children. The goal is for participants to become aware of marginalized groups and create culturally proficient environments, so that all children feel like they belong and as a result can be more successful.

## Who can participate?

Anyone who works with children, and anyone who creates policies for those working with children can participate..

### When does LDS meet?

The program runs from September through May. Participants meet Tuesday evenings about once a month from 4:30-7:45 PM in person.

#### How much does LDS cost?

Tuition for LDS is \$1500, usually paid by the employer.

## What are the requirements for LDS?

Participants are expected to attend all nine class sessions in addition to the orientation session and a two-day retreat. Participants must also complete two implementation projects.

### What topics are covered in LDS?

Class participants will explore marginalized groups: Blacks, Latinx, Asian, LGBTQ+, Economically Disadvantaged, and Trauma Inflicted. Leadership skills are analyzed, and the history of York is also reviewed.

#### **Application Requirements**

Applicants must be employed and sponsored by an accredited, approved public school district or private school. Employers who sponsor program participants should select individuals with the following qualifications:

- Committed to valuing diversity and open to increasing awareness of personal bias.
- Committed to developing personal leadership skills.
- Willing to lead the way to increased acceptance of differences in the classroom, school, and district.
- Able to attend and participate in the mandatory retreat and all curriculum sessions.

Applications from those who meet these qualifications are accepted on a first come, first served basis during the application period of April 1-July 1. Class size is limited to maintain program quality. Tuition for Leadership for Diverse Schools is \$1,500 per person and is billed in July.

# **Mandatory Program Requirements**

Every participant in Leadership for Diverse Schools is expected to complete the following requirements (see enclosed schedule for dates and times):

- Attend a two-day fall retreat: Friday, September 13 (8 am-4 pm) & Saturday, September 14 (8 am-3:30 pm).
   Attendance is mandatory.
- Attend and fully participate in all evening curriculum sessions (October through May). It is necessary for participants to attend each session to participate in the discussions and activities, gain knowledge, and interact with speakers and class members.
- Agree to bring back the knowledge, skills, and tools needed to transform their classroom, school and district into a culturally competent community.

#### **TUITION**

**Tuition for Leadership for Diverse Schools is \$1,500.** Tuition is billed in July and must be paid in full prior to orientation (September 3, 2024). Participants who withdraw from the LDS program less than 5 business days before orientation are assessed a \$150 fee to cover fixed costs incurred by Leadership York. Participants who withdraw from LDS any time after orientation are responsible for the full program tuition amount. No refunds will be issued to either the participant or their sponsoring organization.
