Resilience. To say that our staff, board, and class members were resilient last year is an understatement. Our board led this organization through a tough year, navigating through earned revenue shortfalls and adjusting timing on our strategic plan. Our staff showed up in the biggest way possible, essentially re-thinking every aspect of our programming, being flexible, and continuing to deliver impactful programming. One hundred thirteen (113) class members made the commitment to graduate from one of our six programs, making the investment in themselves and our one York Community.

While some of our programming was held on Zoom, our staff and volunteers found ways to safely hold retreats, some program sessions, and graduation celebrations in person.

And even though 2020-2021 was another challenging year, we had much for which to be grateful!

- Many thanks to Larry Richardson and the YMCA of York and York County for hosting three Opening Retreats at Camp Spirit and multiple program sessions at various YMCA locations.
- We celebrated 15 years of helping educators build culturally proficient communities in their districts through the Leadership for Diverse Schools program.
  - Spark brought together alumni, supporters, and friends at PeoplesBank Park on a stormy day in June to celebrate the year and to honor three individuals who are impacting Leadership York and the community.
- Our customized board trainings reached an all-time high. Staff conducted 19 trainings for York County nonprofit boards!
  - The Women's Giving Circle awarded two grants for the Leadership for Diverse Schools program. One grant will help provide partial scholarships for school districts to send employees through the program while the second grant will enable staff to begin the planning for a LDS 2.0 Conference in 2022.

#### Future Leaders of York Graduate

To be honest, I was never the first person in class to eagerly raise my hand to answer a question. I was scared to make a decision or to speak up about something knowing that it would affect other people. The opening retreat was when I started to positively grow the leadership initiatives that were already within me.

Thanks to being mentored in the Future Leaders of York (FLY) program, I now know how to think and make the best decisions that I can for all those affected. First and foremost, FLY taught me who exactly was being affected when we made a decision. FLY also instilled in me that knowing what type of leader I am strongly influences how effective I can be, no matter where I am. Being a leader has taught me the power of teamwork and collaboration. Considering my fellow FLY students, we all had the same goal but different ways of going about accomplishing a goal. With the essential skill of collaboration, we learned how to maximize everyone's desire, yet still be efficient in our goal. I have learned how to come up with solutions to problems people are having and how to make decisions. I have learned to analyze all the variables of what is going on to help run a well-oiled machine to do great things, while everyone still feels valued, all thanks to Future Leaders of York.

## **Future Leaders of York**

In its 32nd year, the Future Leaders of York program graduated 32 high school students from 21 schools. Students met with community leaders, participated in experiential learning of leadership and interpersonal skills, and awarded \$5,000 to four local nonprofit agencies. The class reviewed 15 applications totaling over \$46,000 and selected the following organizations and programs: Cornerstone Youth Home:

Every Day is a Learning Opportunity; House of Hope: Funding for Counseling and Related Services; LifePath Christian Ministries: Homeless Shelter Linens; and Pursuing Destiny: It Takes a Village Community Baby Shower.

Due to Covid-19, we made many changes to the program this year, using a virtual setting for some of the sessions and adding some different experiences.

## **Leadership Training Program**

Thirty-two people graduated from the 43rd Leadership Training Program class.

Despite Covid-19 restrictions, the class raised over \$127,000, through their team projects reaching over 1,000 community members. A teen room received a makeover, over 2500 pounds of food were donated, a raised garden for an early childhood program was built, and donations to nearly 50 organizations were distributed.



## **Board and Executive Director Development**

Over 500 nonprofit board members and executive directors received solid training and practical resources for effective governance. Board Development programming reached just over 100 York County charities. From customized trainings to technical assistance, our staff, board, and presenters shared their expertise so our alumni can make a difference.



## **Mentorship York**

The 10th Mentorship York class graduated in May 2020 with nine mentees. The mentees spent the year challenging themselves and each other to step up to the next level of servant leadership.

## **Leadership For Diverse Schools**

Twenty-three teachers and administrators from nine school districts were part of the 15th Leadership for Diverse Schools class. The program fosters understanding, acceptance, and tolerance so the participants can be leaders in helping to build culturally proficient communities within their districts and be a change agent in their respected communities. Participants explored such topics as religions, socio-economic biases, Latinx culture, African American culture, sexual orientation, and adverse childhood experiences (ACEs).


